Benefits

From Maintenance allowance user can get fund for Professional course books, Stationary, Residence & Food. As bellow (from hostel date of joining to date of Exam or Max 10 month) 1) For students who are residing in Government Hostels. i) Course duration between 4 to 5 years: 700/- Rs per month (Rs 7000 PA.) ii) Course duration between 2 to 3 years: 500/- Rs per month (Rs 5000 PA.) iii) Course duration bellow 2 years : 500/- Rs per month (Rs 5000 PA.) 2) For students who are eligible for Government hostels but not admitted in Government Hostels. i) Course duration between 4 to 5 years: 1000/- Rs per month (Rs 10000 PA.) ii) Course duration between 2 to 3 years: 700/- Rs per month (Rs 7000 PA.) iii) Course duration bellow 2 years: 500/- Rs per month (Rs 5000 PA.)

Eligibility

- 3) In addition to the maintenance allowance all mandatory fees/ compulsory payable fees (Tuition Fees, Exam Fees & other Fees) by the student to the institutes are covered under this scheme.

- 4) For Professional & Technical Education candidate must go for practice tour then he gets additional max500 Rs or whatever is applicable per year.(If the study tour as part of educational course)

- 5) If Project is mandatory part of course then for printing and typing he get additional maximum up-to 600 Rs whatever is applicable per year, but principal certificate is mandatory.

- 6) for candidate who is studying in Mphil and phd courses they get maintenance allowance as per Post graduation Group A, B,C.

- 7) If the student take admission upto 20th of that month then the maintenance allowance is allowed for this month.
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Eligibility

FOR EVALUATION ONLY

- Student should be disable. (40% or above)

 - The scholarship will not be applicable if the candidate fails or quit the same course in the applied course (incomplete course).

 - Student studying in recognized institute or college out of Maharashtra but he should be residential of MH.

 - For Group B, C, D, and E: If the student fails then he will not be eligible for this scheme.
 - For Group A: If the student fails 1 time, he may be eligible for this scheme, but he will not be eligible if he fails Second time during the full time of education.
 - The candidate who taking distance education from recognized uni/Institution where non-refundable fees has to be paid by the student such students are getting annual Rs. 500/- for books and material purchase.
 - Candidate only can apply Shahu Maharaj Merit Schol with this Scheme. cant apply for another scheme.
 - If candidate is working full time employment then he/she is not eligible.
 - If candidate is from Gov hosteller & he is not getting books and stationery from hostel then he is eligible for additional 1/3 amount of maintenance allowance allowed for hosteller.
 - The candidate residing in college/institute or any other recognized hostel & if he/she pays hostel fees (application point no 11) then the candidates maintenance allowance will be given of hosteller rates.

 - 10) 75 % attendance is mandatory for current year.
 - 11) Applicant will be eligible for scholarship if he / she changes the course Non – Professional to Professional but he will not be eligible if he / she changes the course from Professional to Non – Professional.

 - 5) If due to any medical condition or due to any unforeseeable event the Applicant cannot appear in the annual examination, the head master of the college can approve or certify that if the Applicant would have appeared in the annual examination, he would have been able to pass the examination. If Applicant is admitted through Association of Managements of Unaided Private Medical and Dental Colleges entrance examination or admitted through government common entrance examination then he/she will be eligible the for the freeship.
- 8) Higher and Technical Education Department :
Freeship will be applicable to unaided colleges / government and aided colleges with technical education / Polytechnic and government unaided professional courses.

9) Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development and Fisheries Department :

11) For professional courses Applicant should admitted through CAP round is must.

12) If Applicant fails in particular year then he will get the Tuition Fees and Exam Fees of that particular academic year but he/she will not get the benefit until he/she gets promoted to next higher class.

13) Applicant will be eligible for scholarship if he / she change the course Non – Professional to Professional but he will not be eligible if he / she change the course from Professional to Non – Professional.

14) If an applicant pursuing professional course admitted in private un aided/permanently un aided institute for year 2015-16 onwards fails in the examination two or more times in particular academic course duration then he / she not eligible for the freeship.

15) Scholarships/freeship will continue until Applicant completes one course. Ex. - 11th, 12th Arts - B.A., M.A. , M.Phil., P.H.D. If, Applicant completed B.A and B.Ed. course and later after taking admission for M.A., for M.A. course He/she will not be allowed for scholarship/freeship. But after admission to M.B.A. after B.Ed, it can be eligible for scholarship/freeship as it is a professional postgraduate course.

9) If Applicant get admission in government hostel then he will eligible only 1/3rd amount of hostlers.

10) For OBC Applicants studying in private un-aided institutions, fees structure of government aided institutions will be applicable only for Non – Professional courses (Tuition Fees, Exam Fees and other Fees)
