1. Title: Economics of Tribal Art


Date: 5th July, 2021

2. Title: "Impact of Pollutants on Human Health and Economy"



NAME OF THE RESOURCE PERSON AND THEIR DESIGNATION: Dr. Tejaswi Kamble, an Occupational Therapist


#### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKSHOP:

Over 44 participants attended the event, including Professors of Psychology Mrs. Reeta Kamble and Ms. Renuka Gune. The event began at 10 a.m and ran for one hour forty minutes, covering the various aspects of quality of life-specific adaptation for fall precautions. Different points were discussed in the event, beginning with the fact that physical exercise is for everyone, an explanation of the Wellness and Health Promotion Model, and the different walking variations program. The guest speaker talked about how physical fitness keeps one young, healthy and in good shape and how it is also known to reduce the risk of disease and help create a good sleep cycle. She advised beginners to start practicing physical fitness by finding what suits them best, and exercise is not only for the physical well-being of our body, but it also contributes towards our cognitive well-being. The audience was then allowed to ask their doubts and questions to the speaker. They used the opportunity to ask questions about how late adulthood people are supposed to stay connected with society, how to conquer certain psychological disorders, and how late adulthood people face during it. The event was concluded with a vote of thanks to the guest speaker for her time and the audience for their patience. Finally, the audience was asked to fill out a feedback form, after which their e-certificates of participation were promptly mailed to them.


#### FEEDBACK ANALYSIS:



#### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKSHOP:

On 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021, a very informative guest lecture on "Urban disaster and Social Justice: A Case study of Mumbai floods" had been jointly organized in V.G. Vaze College by The Department of Sociology and Department of History. The resource person for this lecture was a well informed person, Prof. D. Parthasarathy from Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, IIT Bombay. The lecture was conducted on Microsoft Teams, an online platform. Respected Principal of Vaze College Dr. B.B. Sharma, Vice Principal Dean of Arts and Head Department of History Prof. Dr. Preeta Nilesh, Head Department of Sociology Ms. Deepa Shirsat, teachers and students were a part of this guest lecture.

The lecture began at 11am on Microsoft Teams with a warm welcome of Prof. D. Parthasarathy delivered by our respected Principal, Vice Principal and Head Dept of Sociology. The reason for occurrence of floods in urban areas, the techniques of rescuing people from floods, the precautions taken by the government and people before floods was well explained by Parthasarathy sir. He also shed light on the practices of social injustice such as inequality, malpractices with women, discrimination based on caste, class and religion conducted by the departments responsible for creating peace, harmony and Social Justice in the society. How the topography is related to the occurrence of floods was well elaborated by sir. Also deforestation affects the environment negatively resulting in floods was well explained by sir.

Followed by such an informative lecture, all the participants were allowed to freely share their opinions and ask any questions related to the issue. At the end of the lecture question and answer platform was set up by the team where the participants could either raise their hands and ask the question or could type it in the chatbox. After the question and answer session a small vote of thanks to Prof. D. Parthasarathy was delivered by a representative student, Head dept of Sociology and Vice Principal. A feedback form was filled by the participants sharing their experience of this lecture.

The Department of Psychology conducted a webinar on the topic of Left-Handedness on the occasion of International Lefthanders' Day. The webinar took place on 26th August 2021 at 2:00pm and ran for a duration of one hour. A highly qualified guest speaker Ms. Alisha Lalljee (Counselling Psychologist, Psychotherapist, and Special and Remedial Educator) was invited to help the audience understand the uniqueness and psychology of people who are left-handed. Pre-event preparations included the designing of posters and promotions via whatsapp forwards. The event began with an address from our college's Head of Department of Psychology Dr. Neeta Mehta followed by a concept note given by Assistant Professor of Psychology Ms. Reeta Kamble. The student anchors then proceeded to introduce and welcome our guest speaker. Ms. Lalljee covered a wide range of topics—beginning from the explanation of the brain's role in handedness, the difficulties faced by left-handed people (difficulties writing, using spiral bind-books, writing on the chalkboard, playing instruments and so on) and moved on to exploring concepts that were new to the audience such as

handedness in animals (for example, 40% of cats are left-pawed) and the debate on how left-handed people are better in some professions (about 40% of tennis players and 20% of NASA astronauts are left-handed). Further topics she covered included the hereditary nature of handedness, mental health of a left-handed person, its impact on sports, physical health, birth, sleep, driving, learning a language and, delved into the topic of learning disabilities being associated with left-handedness, psychological testing and the gradual building of frustration, anger and low moods. An interactive question and answer session followed after the session officially ended and the audience actively participated and sent in their questions, to which Ms. Laljee provided satisfactory answers. By the end of this session, the speaker also demonstrated how they teach colouring and writing to left-handed people, generally in the case of toddlers. The webinar ended with a vote of thanks by the student volunteers and a few words by Reeta ma'am. All the members of the audience were sent feedback forms and their respective certificates of participation were mailed to them.





# BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKSHOP:


The department of Psychology of KET'S V. G. Vaze College (Autonomous) celebrated the month of Mental Health Awareness i.e., October with a campaign on Mental Health Issues and the nurturant on 5th October, at 2 pm on the online platform of Microsoft Teams. This event was conducted by the third-year students of Psychology under the guidance of the professors of the Psychology department. The event was an informational event where the students took turns in speaking about Mental health issues faced by different groups of people in society. The mental health issues faced by women, children, men, elderly were addressed at the start of the campaign. Then a really good presentation of how these issues are stigmatized in society was done with the help of videos and examples from the entertainment industry. After that, an interactive "Myth or Fact "session was conducted by two students where different situations were presented to the audience and they were asked to adjudge those as a myth or a fact. After each situation why they were, what they were was explained which made it quite a practical exposition. After that a really great segment bringing pop cultural references to the acceptance of mental health issues was made by showing various famous movies and celebrities that express a positive attitude towards mental health issues and respect the agenda. Lastly, various ways and steps that could be taken to maintain one's mental health and ways to get better were shown. This included showing information about various organizations like Manav Foundation and Samaritans Program and various ways for effective communication.

If provided proper training, most of the students and their families will go for not only waste segregation, but also waste management for further recycling of resources.





20. Title: Cancer Awareness Webinar




ATTENDANCE: 71 Members






<u>Brief Description of the Workshop:</u> The self-defence workshop organized in collaboration with NSS was aimed to train the student and staff members of our college about self-defence.


# Brief Description of the Workshop:



# BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKSHOP:



The event began at 10 a.m and ran for one hour forty minutes, covering the various aspects of quality of life-specific adaptation for fall precautions. Different points were discussed in the event, beginning with the fact that physical exercise is for everyone, an explanation of the Wellness and Health Promotion Model, and the different walking variations program. 
