## 1. Student's internship program by Department of Sociology

No. Of Students who participated: 55

#### Collaborating organizations:

- 1. NGO Masoom (9 students)
- 2. NGO Responsible Netism (28 students)
- 3. NGO Stree Mukti Sanghatana (18 students)

#### **Brief Description:**

Department of Sociology and Economics started the internship programme in August 2022. They tied up with three NGOs - Masoom provides educational facilities in the form of night schools, Responsible Netism promotes cyber-safety and Stree Mukti Sanghatana works towards empowerment of women.

Students were required to complete 30 hours of fieldwork with these NGOS. This practice was combined with the Continuous Internal Assessment of students. Nine students worked for Masoom for increasing enrolment in the night schools. Twenty-eight students worked for Stree Mukti Sanghatana for uplifting rag-picking women in Thane by providing them financial literacy, basic education and also by educating their children. Eighteen Students worked with Responsible Netism to provide information on cyber security and safe use of cyberspace to people. They were also a part of a survey-based research project undertaken by Responsible Netism and Mumbai police to study the reporting of online distress.






Brief description:

Collaborating organization: Freedom Farm, Citizens for Animal Protection Foundation, Thane


## **Brief Description:**

# 5. Participation of Tribal children in Dimension and educational visit to Nehru Science center


Date: 20th December 2022

### 7. Anti-Bullying Campaign for children


Date: 4th February, 2023

#### **Brief Description:**

#### Objectives of Taxation Clinic:

- 1. To serve the society by providing consultation regarding tax without charging any fees.
- To educate the general public regarding Taxation Rules & Regulations.
- 3. To help the common man for filing his Income Tax Return/GST Return on his own without the help of Professionals like CA & Tax Practitioners.
- 4. To give legal advice for reducing tax burden like suggesting tax-saving investments, tax deductions which are not known to common man, etc.
- 5. To spread knowledge about various provisions & regulations of Income Tax & GST.

The Taxation Clinic was operated in two stages:


- 1. When the Taxation Clinic was started it was in offline mode. All the visitors were given free consultation regarding taxation. But, physical presence of the visitor was required.
- 2. When the activities of Taxation Clinic were noticed by Maharashtra Times (a leading Marathi Newspaper) they made available their platform where the visitors physical presence was not required. The visitor has to scan a QR Code published in Maharashtra Times & then online appointment was fixed as per the convenience of visitor. One of the panelists used to address queries of the visitors.

Thus, visitors were not required to come to the college physically. They can sit at their home & obtain expert advice from the panelists. Thus, Taxation Clinic is one of its own kind which is unique & different from other advisory centers. Free consultation was given to all the visitors upto 31st July, 2023. Taxation clinic was formed for providing information and guidance for those needing advice & help. It's main objective is to provide information, advice and preliminary guidance to any person needing advice in Income Tax and GST. Free guidance was provided on a wide range of topics of Income Tax and GST. Kelkar College's Department of Accountancy, in collaboration with the Maharashtra Times Culture Club introduced to help public in general for Income Tax queries. Many people have several questions on issues of taxation. All

members of Department of Accountancy volunteered to serve the general public in solving their problems of Taxation totally free of cost. Total 372 participants were given free consultation on Income Tax and GST. 25 Participants were advised online and remaining were given offline/personal advice.
