

#### Introduction:

The Department of Accounts at KET's V.G.Vaze College successfully organized an event on "Banking & Cyber Crime (Prevention & Detection)" on 5th December 2023. The event



aimed to enlighten the audience about the challenges posed by cybercrime in the banking sector and strategies for prevention and detection. The event took place in the Mini Auditorium, with CA Yogesh Sant addressing the gathering and introducing the guest speaker, Mr. Gyan Barah.

**Guest Speaker's Introduction:** The Anchor provided a brief but insightful introduction to the distinguished guest speaker, Mr. Gyan Barah. Known for his expertise in the field, Mr. Barah has an extensive background in banking and cybersecurity.

**CA Yogesh Sant's Address:** CA Yogesh Sant took the stage and shared his experiences

- **1.** Introduction to Financial & Cyber Crime: Mr. Barah shed light on the subject of financial and cybercrime, providing a comprehensive overview.
- 2. Building Awareness Around Cyber Crime: He emphasized the need for awareness regarding the evolving landscape of cyber threats.
- 3. Career Opportunities in Operational & Fraud Risk: Mr. Barah discussed career prospects in the field of operational and fraud risk management, encouraging students to explore these avenues.
- 4. Understanding Fraud: He defined fraud, explained its methodologies, and explored why fraudsters engage in such activities—pressure, capability, and opportunity.
- **5.** Types of Fraud: Mr. Barah covered various types of fraud, including cheque fraud, KYC fraud, retail asset loan fraud, and cyber fraud methods like fishing and skimming.
- 6. Helpline Information: He shared the "1930" helpline number for reporting cybercrime incidents, promoting a proactive approach to handling such situations.

Conclusion and Safety Measures: Mr. Barah concluded by advising attendees to be cautious with personal information, secure their PINs, avoid sharing OTPs, regularly monitor bank accounts, and report any fraud to the "1930" helpline.

for the day was the renowned CA Nikhilesh Soman, a distinguished figure in the financial sector.




