2. Panel discussion - "Queer and Kin: Indian Family Story"
Organizing Body: Vaze Queer Collective

Date: 6th October 2023

Brief Description:

The Panel Discussion, 'Queer and Kin: Indian Family Stories' was conducted on 6th October 2023 by Vaze Queer Collective, in an attempt to bring forth four different points of view on what it is like to be queer in an Indian family, and how it shapes the life of queer children across the globe. The discussion was enlightened by the ideas of Chanchal Singh, Dr. Nilakshi Roy, Vedashree Bhagwat, and Usha Sharma.

Chanchal Singh, a queer individual, mentioned that families most often act as repressive forces towards queer children, rather than supporting them, especially in the beginning. She also shared her experience of coming out to her mother. Moreover, being a law student, she brought the legal aspect of being queer into the discussion, like the need for laws that protect queer people from hate speech and hate crimes.

Dr. Nilakshi Roy, parent of a queer child, accepted that her experience is not the norm.

Being a Professor of English literature, she had already been familiar with modernist writers and themes of queerness, love and shame and it helped her in understanding her daughter better. She urged the audience, filled with young students, to give their parents a chance and if they didn't understand this part of them, then she suggested that they continue living fearlessly with more vigor.

Ms. Vedashree Bhagwat joined the conversation as a queer-affirmative therapist in practice and shed light on how queer people struggle with anxiety, depression, internalized queer-phobia, and so on. She spoke about how dealing with the grief of the loss of family one can face is largely due to the bigoted sense of "normalcy" in society.

Finally, Usha Sharma, an ally and researcher of 'Inclusive Education' talks about how there are teachers at school level who reinforce harmful stereotypes and that is where change needs to be brought. It is also the reason why she chose this field of research. She shared instances of prejudice that she has seen queer children face and how it had affected them in their developing years.

In conclusion, this discussion was extremely insightful and invigorating. The audience got the chance to interact with the panellist and ask them several questions like approaching parents and talking to them about Asexuality; various coping mechanisms one can use to deal with the anxieties of coming out; how queer children often use academic validation as a response to feeling less loved and appreciated for their queerness; and much more.

Brief Description of the Workshop:

The program was organized on September 16, 2023, on the occasion of the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, a workshop took place at Ganeshpuri Village, Maharashtra, aimed at empowering local farmers with Organic farming and its importance. The challenge with organic farming and modern approach towards farming with scientific techniques were also focused. The workshop was a collaborative effort between the Department of Botany, Nature club & Green Initiative committee and Prasad Chikitsa.








6. A Student Internship Program in collaboration with Responsible Netism

Duration: October 2023 to March 2024

Organizing Body: Department of Sociology

Collaborating body: NGO - "Responsible Netism" initiative by Ahaan Foundation

Brief Description of the Internship Program:

In the domain of education in general and sociology to be specific, bridging the gap between book view and field is of paramount importance. Recognizing this imperative, the sociology and economics departments of KET's V. G. Vaze College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), Mulund partnered with Ahaan Foundation through their project "Responsible Netism". Through this initiative, the foundation aims at advocating the cause of cyber-wellness among among women and children by means of educating and promoting responsible online behaviour. Under this internship program, the students were supposed to complete 30 hours of fieldwork. They were given three tasks out of which they had to select any two. These tasks included the following:

• Survey in geographical area:

This activity required the students to conduct a survey in their respective geographical areas for which they were provided with a predetermined questionnaire. It contained closed ended questions. The students visited households and entered the data manually by interviewing the members. Each student completed 150 surveys under this task.

Content creation:

This task aimed at creating awareness through social media by means of creative and engaging content. The students who chose this activity, created blogs, posters, memes, reels and long form videos. They covered a wide array of topics including password safety, gaming safety, two step authentication on social media apps, online banking frauds, OTP scams, reporting mechanisms, etc.

A Street play was organized in two public gardens in Mulund East, namely, Raje Sambhaji Garden and Dr. Chintamani Dwarakanath Deshmukh Garden on 13th March, 2024 at 8.00 am and 14th March, 2024 at 5.30 pm respectively. The students covered three most important areas which included photo morphing, trolling and online financial frauds (OTP scams). The

play garnered wide public attention.

The internship acquainted the students with the challenges that they would face once they get out of their comfort zones and dive into the deeper areas of the pool and the ways they can tackle them. It provided a platform for the students to showcase their skills and creativity and leverage their connections for the purpose of bringing change. They got a chance to polish their skills like interpersonal and communication skills, problem solving and critical thinking, creativity, rejection handling, public speaking and performance, research, etc.

Brief Description:

10th September, 2023 - Department of Psychology of in Collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Thane East, organised a Suicide Prevention Day Awareness Campaign at Talao Pali, Thane (west). The theme for the Suicide Prevention Day Campaign was "Creating Hope Through Action". The exhibition was held in the Psychology lab in collaboration with the Department of English Literature. 
During this interaction, teachers and students talked about their countries, culture, traditions, about their educational institutions. The decoration of the program was national dances - Russian folk and Indian Kathak.






