## Panorama - The Virtual Bookshelf

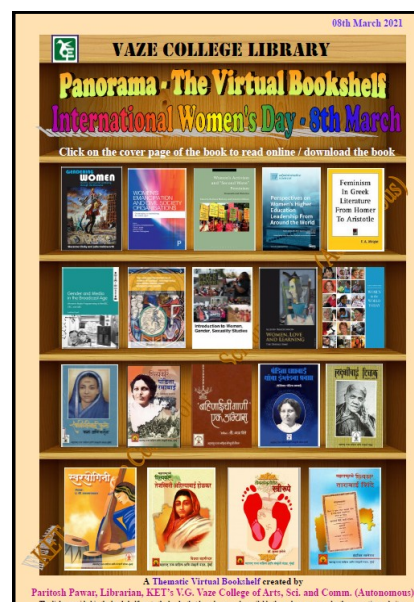
Vaze College Library launched 'Panorama – The Virtual Bookshelf' on the auspicious occasion of International Women's Day - 8th March 2021.

'Panorama' is a thematic display of books that can be downloaded and read on the PCs or mobiles. Clicking/touching the Cover Page of the book in the bookshelf, allows downloading / reading the respective book online. The later versions of Panorama will have books on different themes. Panorama will be a regular library activity to bridge the gap between the users and downloadable e-books. It has been proposed to have at least one virtual bookshelf every month based on different themes.

The first virtual bookshelf has 19 books in English and Marathi on a variety of interdisciplinary topics related to women's studies, feminism, literature, gender studies along with some motivating biographies.

Panorama is circulated among the students and teaching faculty members through whatsapp and email. Panorama is also available for download on the homepage of the library's website.

### In Brief: Open Access e-Resources through the Library website

The E-Resources Page on the Library Website is continuously being updated with new links being added on a regular basis for benefit of library users. Currently, more than **60,81,99,160 (Sixty Crores Eighty One Lakhs Ninety Nine Thousand One Hundred and Sixty)** of freely downloadable e-resources can be accessed through links provided on the E-resources page (as per data compiled from the sources of linked websites). Resources have been curated and bifurcated into E-Books, E-Journals, Audio Books, Video Journals, E-Databases, E-Datasets, Electronic Theses and Dissertations, Institutional / Knowledge Reposi-

tories, Rare Books and Manuscripts, etc. for ease of use. Links have also been provided for COVID-19 resources and also for the vaccines for COVID-19.

The Library has been trying to disseminate as much official information on COVID-19 as possible through the **COVID-19 E-Resources Section** on the **Home Page** of the library website, since the lockdown began last year in March 2020.

Feature Article: **WORLD HEALTH DAY— 7th April**



April 7 of each year marks the celebration of World Health Day. The World Health Organization was founded on 07th April 1948. The World Health Organization is a specialized agency of the United Nations responsible for international public health. From its inception at the First Health Assembly in 1948 and since taking effect in 1950, the celebration of World Health Day has aimed to create awareness of a specific health theme to highlight a priority area of concern for the World Health Organization.

The Constitution of World Health Organization was adopted by the International Health Conference held in New York from 19th June to 22nd July 1946, signed on 22nd July 1946 by the representatives of 16 states and entered into force from 7th April 1948, a date we now celebrate every year as World Health Day. The full constitution of the WHO can be read online / downloaded by [clicking here](#).

WHO Member States are grouped into six regions - Africa, Americas, South East Asia, Europe, Eastern Mediterranean and Western Pacific. Each region has a regional office.

More than 7000 people from more than 150 countries work for the Organization in 150 WHO offices in countries, territories and areas, six regional offices, at the Global Service Centre in Malaysia and at the headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland.



In addition to medical doctors, public health specialists, scientists and epidemiologists, WHO staff include people trained to manage administrative, financial, and information systems, as well as experts in the fields of health statistics, economics and emergency relief.

**What is the World Health Organization's definition of health?**

Health is a state of complete physical, mental and social well-being and not merely the absence of disease or infirmity. The bibliographic citation for this definition is: Preamble to the Constitution of WHO as adopted by the International Health Conference, New York, 19 June - 22 July 1946; signed on 22 July 1946 by the representatives of 61 States (Official Records of WHO, no. 2, p. 100) and entered into force on 7 April 1948. The definition has not been amended since 1948.

**WHO— Role in COVID-19 Pandemic:**

WHO has played a major role in the COVID-19 global pandemic. WHO has been striving for mitigating global health security risks during the pandemic through containing emergence and spread of COVID-19, providing technical guidance on it, working in collaboration with scientists, business, and global health organizations to speed up the pandemic response and giving advice for international travel and trade in relation to the outbreak to stop disease to spread further.

A lot of information on COVID-19 virus and the Vaccines has been made available on the WHO website.

**WHO Coronavirus (COVID-19) Dashboard** available on the WHO website gives global updates about new cases reported, confirmed cases, deaths due to COVID-19, and vaccine doses administered. 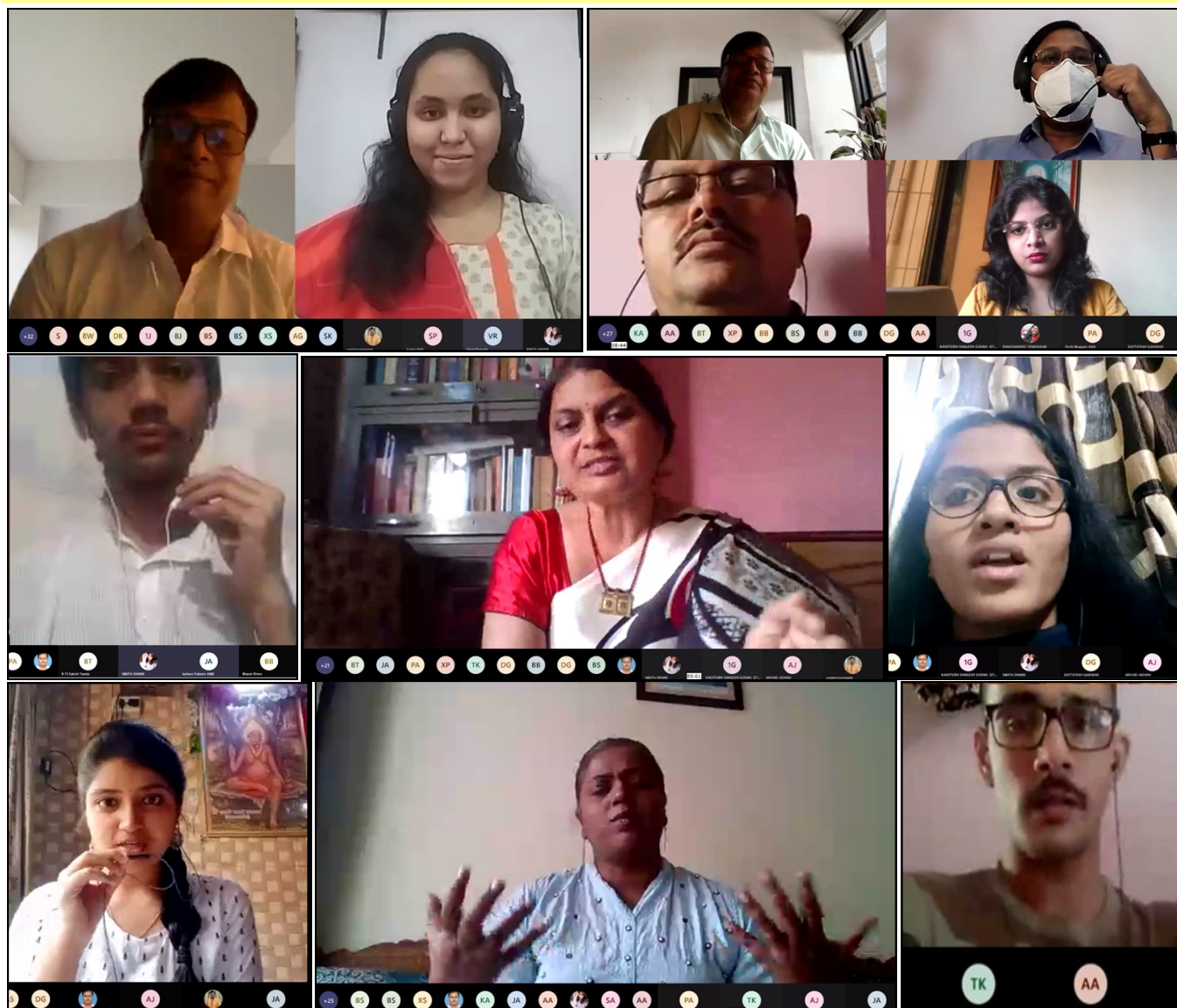

हा सुप्रसिद्ध संवाद ज्या सुप्रसिद्ध ‘नटसम्राट’ या चित्रपटातील आहे, त्या नाटकाचे लेखक, ज्ञानपीठ विजेते, महाराष्ट्राचे थोर कवीवर्य श्री. वि. वा. शिरवाडकर उर्फ कुसुमाग्रज यांचा जन्मदिन २७ फेब्रुवारी हा दिवस ‘जागतिक मराठी भाषा दिन’ म्हणून साजरा केला जातो. ‘मराठी भाषा गौरव दिनाचे’ औचित्य साधून महाविद्यालयाच्या ग्रंथालयातर्फे निबंध स्पर्धा आयोजित करण्यात आली आहे, ह्या निबंध स्पर्धेच्या आयोजकांचे, मी कु. प्रतीक्षा अरुण धोत्रे...मनापासून आभार मानते. तुम्ही आम्हा विद्यार्थ्यांना आमचे विचार व्यक्त करण्याची जी सुवर्णसंधी दिलीत, त्याबद्दल मनःपूर्वक धन्यवाद!

२७ फेब्रुवारी हा मराठी राजभाषा दिन! त्यानिमित्ताने मराठी भाषेच्या सद्यःस्थितीसंबंधात चर्चा करणे उचित ठरावे. इंग्रजीचे आक्रमण आणि जागतिकीकरणाच्या झंझावातात मराठी भाषा आणि संस्कृती नष्ट होण्याची भीती सातत्याने व्यक्त केली जाते. परंतु आज जागतिक संदर्भातही मराठीभाषिकांची असलेली प्रचंड संख्या पाहता तिच्या ज्हासाची ही भीती अनाठायी आहे असेच म्हणावे लागेल. खरे तर आज मराठी भाषेच्या संवर्धनाचे अनेकानेक मार्ग खुले झाले आहेत. संगणकीय तंत्रज्ञानही मराठी भाषेत उपलब्ध होत आहे. प्रसार माध्यमांचा वापरही दिवसेंदिवस वाढत आहे. विविध ज्ञानशाखांमधील उपयुक्त ज्ञान आज मराठीत येत आहे. ह्या सर्व गोष्टींचा विचार करुन मग चर्चेला विषय मिळतो, ‘मराठी भाषा समृद्ध करण्यामध्ये प्रसार माध्यमांचे योगदान’. प्रत्यक्ष विषयाला सुरुवात करण्याआधी मराठी भाषेच्या काही ठळक बाबींवर एक नजर टाकूया. मराठी भाषा ही इंडो-युरोपीय भाषाकुळातील एक भाषा आहे. २०११ च्या जनगणनेनुसार, भारत देशात मराठी भाषकांची एकूण लोकसंख्या सुमारे ९ कोटी आहे. मराठी मातृभाषा असणा-या लोकांच्या संख्येनुसार मराठी ही जगातील दहावी व भारतातील तिसरी भाषा आहे. महाराष्ट्र हे ‘मराठी भाषिकांचे राज्य’ म्हणून त्याला वेगळे महत्त्व प्राप्त झालेले आहे. आजतागायत मराठी भाषेतून अनेक श्रेष्ठ साहित्यकृती निर्माण झालेल्या आहेत आणि त्यात सातत्यपूर्ण रीतीने भर पडत आहे.

आजकाल अगदी लहान-सहान मुलंदेखील प्रसार माध्यमांचा सर्रासपणे वापर करताना दिसतात. तसे प्रसार माध्यमांचे बरेच फायदे-तोटे आहेत परंतु त्यातील एक महत्त्वाचा फायदा म्हणजे मराठी भाषा समृद्ध करण्यामध्ये

प्रसार माध्यमांचे असलेले योगदान. वृत्तपत्रे, मासिके, त्रैमासिके (तीन महिन्यांनी प्रसिद्ध होणारी मासिके), रेडिओ यांचे मराठी भाषेचे मराठीपण जपण्यामध्ये असलेले योगदान तर खूप पूर्वीपासूनचे आहे; परंतु आता त्यात गुगल, यूट्यूब, इंस्टाग्राम, फेसबुक आणि अजूनही अशा बऱ्याचकाही प्रसार माध्यमांची भर पडली आहे.

यूट्यूब सारख्या सुप्रसिद्ध प्रसार माध्यमावर आजकाल मराठी भाषकांचे विडीओस् भरपूर प्रमाणात पहायला मिळतात. मग त्यात, कानाला ऐकायला गोड वाटणारी मराठी 'आगरी' बोलीभाषा वापरून विनोद करणारा 'विनायक माळी' असेल किंवा मग... अस्सल पुणेरी भाषेत लोकांशी विविध विषयांवर चर्चा करून मनोरंजन करणारा... 'मराठी किडा' ह्या यूट्यूब-चॅनेल चा सूत्रसंचालक सूरज खटावकर असेल. दिनांक ७ मार्च २०२१ पर्यंत **4.4M Subscribers** चा पल्ला गाठणारे '**Zee Music Marathi**' हे यूट्यूब-चॅनेल मराठी रसिकांपर्यंत विविध नव्या-जुन्या चित्रपटांमधील गाणी पोहोचवण्याचे काम करून मराठीची गोडी जपत आहे. एवढेच काय तर, जर्मनीमध्ये राहून तिथल्या चालीरिती किंवा तेथला दिनक्रम व इतर गोष्टी मराठी भाषेमध्ये, ब्लॉग (Vlogs) बनवून आपल्यापर्यंत पोहोचवून बाहेरील देशातील विविध ज्ञानशाखांमधील उपयुक्त ज्ञान मराठी भाषेत आपल्यापर्यंत पोहोचवणारी श्वेतल कदम असेल... किंवा मग अहिराणी, कोंकणी, कोळी, मालवणी, वाडवळी व-हाडी, हलबी अशा मराठी बोलीभाषांमध्ये लिखाण करून मराठी भाषेची विविधता व सौंदर्य जपणारे छोटे-मोठे कलाकार, लेखक, कवी मंडळी असतील.

फेसबुक सारख्या प्रसार माध्यमावर देखील वेगवेगळी पेजेस तयार करून काहीजण त्यावर मराठी लेख, कविता, संवाद, विनोद, चुटकुले पोस्ट करून मराठी भाषेचं अस्तित्व टिकवण्यात हातभार लावत आहेत. ह्या सर्व प्रसार माध्यमांना गृहीत धरताना, मराठी भाषा समृद्ध करण्याचं काम, खूप वर्षांपासून प्रमाणिकपणे करणा-या एका महत्त्वाच्या पठ्ठ्याला विसरून चालणार नाही.... तो म्हणजे 'दूरदर्शन' ! आणि हो .. त्याचा सहकारी रेडिओ सुद्धा. त्यात पुण्याच्या **so called** रेडिओजॉकी शो..शो..शोनालीचा देखील मोलाचा वाटा आहे, असे म्हणायला हरकत नाही. खरं सांगायचं म्हटलं तर.... दूरदर्शनवर दाखवल्या जाणा-या काही विचित्र कंटाळवाण्या अतिशयोक्ती करणा-या मालिका वगळता, बरेच कार्यक्रम हे मराठी भाषेच्या समृद्धीमध्ये मोलाचे काम करत आहेत. **Bollywood, Tollyhood** आणि **Hollywood** मध्ये बरेच धमाकेदार आणि नवनवीन चित्रपट येत असतानादेखील मराठी चित्रपटसृष्टी ही मराठी रसिकांमध्ये लोकप्रियच आहे, हे नवल ! दूरदर्शन हे माध्यम दुर्गम भागांतही पोचले आहे. आणि आता तर ते सातासमुद्रापलीकडेही पाहिले जाते. या माध्यमामुळे मराठीचा नकळत का होईना, प्रसार-प्रचार होत आहे. या प्रभावी माध्यमांमध्ये काम करणाऱ्यांनी मराठीच्या बाबतीत जाणीवपूर्वक काम केले पाहिजे.

थोडक्यात सांगायचं म्हटलं तर, आज संगणक- इंटरनेट युगात मराठीला जागतिक स्तरावर विस्तार पावण्यासाठी चांगल्या संधी निर्माण झाल्या आहेत.

अगदी अलीकडेपर्यंत संगणकावर मराठी हे इंग्लिश भाषेसारखे रोमन लिपीतून लिहावे लागायचे. आज सॉफ्टवेअरच्या मदतीने संगणकावर देवनागरीत लिहिता येणे शक्य झाले आहे. युनिकोडमुळे तर ते आणखीनच सोपे झाले आहे. 'विकिपिडिया' सारख्या जागतिक ज्ञानकोशात इतर भाषांच्या बरोबरीने मराठीतून ज्ञानसंक्रमण करण्याचे माध्यम खुले झाले आहे. मायक्रोसॉफ्टने संगणकावर मराठीतून सर्व प्रकारचा पत्रव्यवहार, माहितीची साठवणूक, हिशेब ठेवण्याची सुविधा उपलब्ध करून दिली आहे. मराठी-इंग्रजी शब्दकोश, शुद्धलेखनाची आज्ञावली आता संगणकाच्या पडद्यावर, इंटरनेटच्या महाजालावर उपलब्ध आहे. मराठी वर्तमानपत्रे इंटरनेटच्या माध्यमातून जगातल्या कुठल्याही कोपऱ्यात आता वाचता येतात.

अशा प्रकारे आपल्याला एक गोष्ट तर स्पष्ट झाली की, प्रसार माध्यमांचा मराठी भाषेच्या समृद्धीमध्ये खूप मोलाचा वाटा आहे. मराठी भाषेच्या संवर्धनाचा विचार करताना ती जिवंत राहणार आहे आणि आपण ती जिवंत ठेवणार आहोत, हे पहिल्यांदा गृहीत धरायला हवे. भाषेच्या विविध बोली जोपासणे आणि वाढवणेही तितकेच गरजेचे आहे.

भाषा कोणती ही असो, त्या भाषेच्या समृद्धीमध्ये त्या भाषेचा प्रचार-प्रसार, संवर्धन यांचा समावेश होतो. जास्तीत जास्त लोकांनी जास्तीत जास्त ठिकाणी ती भाषा बोलणे हा कुठल्याही भाषेच्या संवर्धनाचा पहिला टप्पा आहे. भाषेच्या संवर्धनासाठी संख्यात्मक वाढ आणि वर्चस्व आवश्यक आहे. हिंदी व बंगालीच्या उदाहरणावरून ते आपल्याला स्पष्ट दिसते. याबाबत मराठीची परिस्थिती आशादायक आहे. कारण आजच्या घडीला मराठी मातृभाषा असणाऱ्यांची संख्या सुमारे आठ ते साडेआठ कोटी आहे. पुढच्या ५० वर्षांतसुद्धा ही संख्या भक्कमच राहणार आहे. त्यामुळे सर्वत्र आपण हिरीरीने मराठी बोलले पाहिजे. ती बोलायला लाजायचे कारण नाही. आपण आपल्या भूमीत भक्कम उभे आहोत, आपली भाषा ही जगातल्या प्रमुख भाषांपकी एक आहे, आपण तिच्यात सर्व व्यवहार करू शकतो, या आत्मविश्वासाने ती बोलण्याची आवश्यकता आहे.

'भाषा ही आपली कवचकुंडले किंवा प्राणवायू आहे' असे म्हटले तर ती अतिशयोक्ती होणार नाही. म्हणून शेवटी एवढंच बोलता येईल की, 'मायबोली' या शब्दाने ( खरोखर किंवा नाटकीपणाने) हळवे न होता, तिच्याविषयीच्या अभिमानाचे उमाळे काढत न बसता, निव्वळ गौरवाच्या भूमिकेतून तिच्याकडे न पाहता, भाषिक अस्मितेच्या लबाड राजकारणाला न भुलता, अन्य भाषांसंबंधीचे पूर्वग्रह उराशी न बाळगता मराठी भाषा काल-परवा कशी होती, याची तटस्थपणे जाणीव करून घ्यायला हवी आणि तिच्या सद्यः रंग-रूपातील दोष आणि ढोंग यांचा नायनाट करायला हवा, उद्याच्या जबाबदारीसाठी ती समृद्ध कशी होईल याचा स्वच्छ विचार व्हायला हवा.

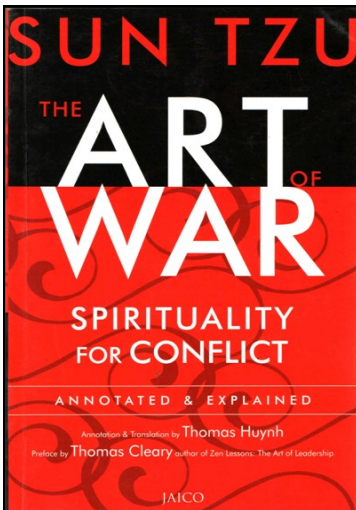

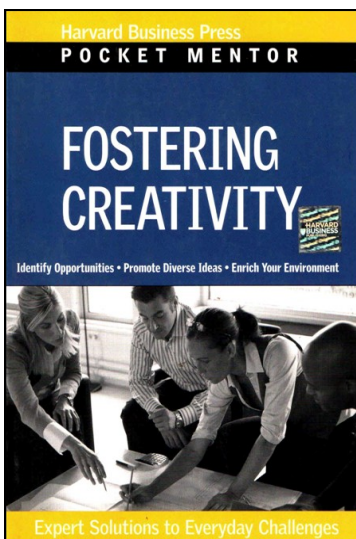
