

### सभेचे इतिवृत्त:

१) सर्वप्रथम मराठी अभ्यास मंडळ अध्यक्ष व विभागप्रमुख प्रा. अरविंद जाधव यांनी उपस्थितांचे स्वागत करून

सभेला सुरूवात केली व मागील सभेचे इतिवृत्त वाचून दाखवले. यावेळी मागील सभेत मान्य झालेले प्रस्ताव व त्याची अंमलबजावणी यावर त्यांनी थोडक्यात चर्चा केली.

२) शैक्षणिक वर्ष २३-२४ संभाव्य बदलणा-या अभ्यासक्रमावर चर्चा या विषयांतर्गत प्रा. निकिता विचारे यांनी दूरस्थ प्रणालीद्वारे अभ्यासक्रमाचे सादरीकरण केले. त्यावर उपस्थित सदस्यांनी चर्चा केली. या चर्चेदरम्यान लवकरच प्रथम वर्षापासून नवीन शैक्षणिक धोरण लागू करण्यात येणार असल्याने नवीन अभ्यासक्रमात विद्यार्थ्यांना पुरेसा वाव मिळणे कठीण जाईल व एका वर्षाच्या कालावधीत नवीन अभ्यासक्रमास पुरेसा न्याय मिळेलच असे नाही म्हणून द्वितीय वर्ष कला शाखेच्या या अभ्यासक्रमात यावर्षी कोणताही बदल न करता तृतीय वर्षाच्या अभ्यासक्रमात काही ठिकाणी बदल करावा असा प्रस्ताव मराठी विभागप्रमुख प्रा. अरविंद जाधव यांनी मांडला. या प्रस्तावास सर्वानुमते मान्यता देण्यात आली व द्वितीय वर्षाच्या अभ्यासक्रमात कोणताही बदल केला गेला नाही. त्यानंतर तृतीय वर्षाच्या सत्र पाच व सहा

मधील अभ्यासक्रमवार चर्चा करण्यात आली. या चर्चेदरम्यान अभ्यासपत्रिका क्रमांक IV, V व VII या पूर्णपणे तात्विक व सिद्धांतिक असल्याने यात कोणताही बदल न करण्याचे सर्वानुमते ठरले.

अभ्यासपत्रिका क्रमांक VI - साहित्य आणि समाज याच्या अभ्यासक्रमावर चर्चा करण्यात आली. त्यानुसार अभ्यासक्रमातील तात्विक भागात कोणताही बदल न करता अभ्यासासाठी निवडण्यात आलेल्या प्रत्यक्ष साहित्यकृतीत बदल करावा असा प्रस्ताव प्रा. निकिता विचारे यांनी मांडला. यानुसार सत्र पाच मधील स्त्रीवादी जाणीवेचे साहित्य या घटकांतर्गत 'अव्याहत वाटा वेदनांच्या' या वंदना भागवत यांच्या कादंबरी ऐवजी वेगळ्या कादंबरीचा विचार व्हावा असे प्रा. अरविंद जाधव यांनी सुचवले. यावेळी इतर स्त्रीवादी कथन साहित्याचा विचार केला त्यानंतर नीरजा यांच्या 'ओल हरवलेली माती', या कथासंग्रहाची सर्वानुमते निवड करण्यात आली. यानंतर सत्र सहा दलित जाणीवेचे साहित्य या घटकांतर्गत सिद्धार्थ तांबे यांच्या 'जाता नाही जात' हे नाटक गेली अनेक वर्षे अभ्यासक्रमात असल्याने या नाटकाऐवजी अन्य नाट्यकृतीचा विचार व्हावा असा प्रस्ताव प्रा. निकिता विचारे यांनी मांडला. यावेळी काही दलित जुन्या-नव्या नाट्यकृतींचा विचार करण्यात आला दलित नाटकांचा विचार करता पहिलं स्त्रीलिखित दलित नाटक म्हणून प्रज्ञा पवार यांचे 'धादांत खैरलांजी' या नाटकाचा विचार करावा व हे नाटक कोणत्याही अभ्यासक्रमात नसल्याने हा वेगळा प्रयत्न ठरू शकतो असे डॉ. शीतल पावस्कर यांनी सुचविले. नवीन नाटकांचे स्वागत व्हायला हवे असे मत डॉ. राजेंद्र करनकाळ यांनी या चर्चेदरम्यान मांडले. शेवटी 'धादांत खैरलांजी' या नाटकाचा अभ्यासक्रमात समावेश करावा असे सर्वानुमते ठरले.

त्यानंतर अभ्यासपत्रिका क्र. VIII - आधुनिक मराठी साहित्य सत्र पाच - अभ्यासक्रमावर चर्चा करण्यात आली. अभ्यासक्रमातील तात्विक भाग व आधुनिक कथा साहित्यकृती कादांचीर -जी.के.ऐनापूरे यात कोणताही बदल करण्यात आला नाही. मात्र या सत्रातील आधुनिक कादंबरी या घटकातील अभिराम भडकमकर यांची 'अॅट एनी कॉस्ट' ही कादंबरी बदलून तिथे एखाद्या नवीन साहित्यकृतीची निवड करावी असा प्रस्ताव प्रा. अरविंद जाधव यांनी मांडला. यावर अधिक चर्चा करून डॉ.शीतल पावस्कर यांनी किरण गुरव यांच्या 'जुगाड' या कादंबरीचा विचार करावा असे सुचवले. सुशिक्षित बेकरांची समस्या मांडणारी ही कादंबरी भाषिक अवकाशाचा विचार करता विद्यार्थ्यांना सोयीची ठरू शकते म्हणून या कादंबरीची निवड सर्वानुमते करण्यात आली. सत्र सहा मधील आधुनिक कविता व नाटक यातील तात्विक भाग व साहित्यकृतीत कोणताही बदल करण्यात आला नाही.

अभ्यासपत्रिका क्र. IX व्यवसायभिमुख मराठी या अभ्यासक्रमावर चर्चा करताना सत्र पाच मधील काही त्रुटी व येणाऱ्या अडचणींचा विचार करून घटक क्रमांक एक व दोन मधील काही भाग वगळावा व तिसरा घटक तसाच ठेवावा असा प्रस्ताव प्रा. अरविंद जाधव यांनी मांडला. त्यानुसार प्रत्यक्ष अध्यापनातील अडचणी व अनुभव याची सविस्तर चर्चा करून घटक एक मधील ललित साहित्याचे भाषांतर व त्यातील शैलीविषयक समस्या तसेच घटक दोन मधील उतान्याचे आकलन हे घटक वगळण्यात आले. या प्रस्तावास सर्वांची अनुमती मिळाली. त्यांतर सत्र सहाच्या अभ्यासक्रमावर चर्चा करण्यात आली. त्यानुसार घटक एक मधील ग्रंथपरीक्षणासाठी निवडलेल्या साहित्यकृतीत कोणताही बदल करण्यात आला नाही. घटक तीन मधील चित्रपट परीक्षण यात बदल करावा असा प्रस्ताव प्रा. अरविंद जाधव यांनी मांडला. या चर्चेदरम्यान आधीच्या तीन चित्रपटांच्या सामाजिक आशयाच्या 'फॅन्डी' या सिनेमा ऐवजी 'देऊळ' (दिग्दर्शक उमेश कुलकर्णी) चित्रपटाच्या निवडीसंदर्भात प्रस्ताव मांडण्यात आला यावेळी काही सिनेमांवर चर्चा करण्यात आली व सर्वानुमते 'देऊळ' या सिनेमाची निवड करण्यात आली, आधीच्या 'अशी ही बनवाबनवी' व 'कच्चा लिंबू' यात बदल करण्यात आला नाही.


१) नवीन शैक्षणिक धोरण (NEP) अभ्यासक्रम याविषयावर चर्चा करताना प्रा. वैशाली धम्मपथी (कला व मानव्यविद्या अधिष्ठाता, वि. ग. वझे महाविद्यालय (स्वायत्त) मुलुंड ) यांनी डॉ. रवींद्र कुलकर्णी

यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखाली स्थापन करण्यात आलेल्या समितीच्या शिफारसीनुसार मराठी विभाग अभ्यासक्रमात बदल करणार असल्याचे सांगून त्या संभाव्य बदलांवर चर्चा केली. त्यानंतर त्यांनी NEP अंतर्गत चौथे वर्ष म्हणजे बीए ऑनर्स सुरू करण्यासाठी नवीन शैक्षणिक धोरणाच्या मार्गदर्शक तत्वानुसार महाविद्यालयाला विद्यापीठाकडे चौथ्या वर्षाची परवानगी घेणे क्रमप्राप्त असल्याचे सांगून त्याकरिता अभ्यासमंडळाच्या सर्व सदस्यांसमोर ही परवानगी घेण्यास अनुमती द्यावी असा प्रस्ताव मांडला. व त्यांच्या या प्रस्तावास सर्वानुमते मान्यता देण्यात आली.

३) ऐनवेळी येणा-या विषयात अभ्यासक्रमास मिळालेल्या आजी- माजी विद्यार्थी, शिक्षक व उद्योजक यांच्याकडून मिळालेल्या प्रतिक्रिया यावर चर्चा करण्यात आली. त्यातील त्रुटी जाणून घेऊन नवीन अभ्यासक्रमात आवश्यक बदल करण्याचे ठरले. या सभेस वि.ग. वझे महाविद्यालय मराठी अभ्यास मंडळ मुंबई निद्यापीठ कुलगुरू नामनिर्देशित प्रतिनिधी प्रा. अभिजीत देशपांडे त्यांच्या वैयक्तिक अडचणींमुळे उपस्थित राहू शकले नाहीत म्हणून त्यांना सदर सभेतील प्रस्ताव पाठवून या प्रस्तावास अनुमती मिळण्यासंदर्भात चर्चा झाली.





#### **Minutes of the Meeting:**

The meeting started promptly at 5.30 pm with all members in attendance, except Dr. Nilakshi Roy and Dr. Suddhaseel Sen, whose leave of absence was granted. It began with a reading of the Minutes of the previous BoS meeting, and a review of the departmental activities of the last academic year 2022-2023, as read out by Dr. Dinesh Kumar, Chairperson, Board of Studies (English), followed by a few suggestions for change in the TYBA syllabus. In keeping with the implementation of the NEP 2020, the new structure of the courses as applicable in the subject of English for FY programmes across disciplines was discussed. These changes suggested were then accepted by all members present.

The structure of the syllabi of the following subjects was placed before the BoS:

### **Suggestions and Observations:**

The following observations and suggestions were made by the Board members during the meeting of the Board of Studies (English) held on Monday, 24th April 2023, at 5.30 pm:

1. For FYBA Literature Paper I, it was suggested by the chairperson that the new syllabi be aligned with the NEP 2020 structure and the same was unanimously adopted.
2. For Communication Skills and Business Communication, it was suggested by the chairperson that the new syllabi be aligned with the NEP 2020 structure and the same was unanimously adopted. It was also suggested by Dr. Mandar Talvekar that tutorials be accommodated under the practical sessions under SEC/ AEC as per the NEP 2020 structure. The same was accepted by all members present.
3. For SYBA American Literature (Paper III), the following changes were suggested:
  - a. To replace the novel in Unit 2 with Toni Morrison's *Tar Baby* in Sem III
  - b. To replace the play in Unit 2 with Marsha Norman's *Night Mother* in Sem IVBoth these suggestions were unanimously accepted to be implemented into effect immediately.
4. For the TYBA syllabi, the following changes were suggested:
  - a. To replace the essays of Charles Lamb with that of William Hazlitt in Paper VII, Sem V
  - b. To replace the novel by Elizabeth Gaskell with George Eliot's *Middlemarch* in Paper VII, Sem VIBoth these suggestions were unanimously accepted to be implemented into effect immediately.
5. Dr. Dinesh Kumar suggested that a **Post Graduate degree** in English be commenced under the NEP 2020 plan which was seconded by Dr. Pratima Das. It was unanimously resolved to accept and implement the same with immediate effect.

The meeting ended with all members present expressing satisfaction over the existing content and suggested changes.







### बैठक का कार्यवृत्त :

- 1- वर्ष 2022-23 के पाठ्यक्रम के संबंध में बीओएस सदस्यों के समक्ष पाठ्यक्रम समीक्षा प्रस्तुत की गई। पाठ्यक्रम के संबंध में विद्यार्थियों फीडबैक फॉर्म दिया गया था जिसकी चर्चा उपस्थित सभी सदस्यों के सम्मुख प्रस्तुत की गई।
- 2- हिन्दी विभाग द्वारा पाठ्येतर अन्य कार्यक्रमों /गतिविधियों के आयोजन के विषय में बीओएस के सभी सदस्यों को जानकारी दी गई।
- 3- द्वितीय वर्ष कला तथा तृतीय वर्ष कला के पाठ्यक्रम में बदलाव के विषय में सभी सदस्यों को जानकारी दी गई, पाठ्यक्रम में बदलाव के बारे में विस्तार से चर्चा सभी उपस्थित सदस्यों द्वारा की गई। सभी सदस्यों द्वारा उक्त पाठ्यक्रम को स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई ।
- 4- 'नई शिक्षा नीति' को ध्यान में रखते हुए तैयार खाका सम्मुख रखा गया जिसके विषय में सभी ने अपने विचार प्रस्तुत किए । डीएससी पर बात करते हुए डॉ. सतीश पाण्डेय ने कहा कि हम यहाँ सरल हिन्दी के रूप में हास्य व्यंग्य जैसी पुस्तकें जो कुछ हल्की व सामान्य लगे तथा विद्यार्थियों में रोचकता पैदा करे, साथ ही पाठ्यक्रम के माध्यम से मूल्यपरक भी हो । डॉ. अनिल सिंह ने हरिशंकर परसाई जी की रचनाएं को लेने की बात कही तथा डॉ. उषा मिश्रा ने लंबी कहानियों के साथ ही छोटे छोटे पुस्तकों को प्रथम वर्ष कला में लेने की बात कही। जिससे कि व्यावहारिक हिन्दी के साथ-साथ व्याकरण के कुछ पाठ भी सम्मिलित हो सकें। डॉ. सतीश पाण्डेय ने पाठ्यक्रम में जोड़ी जानेवाली कुछ रचनाओं की सूची तैयार करने के लिए कक्षा त्रिमासे की चर्चा के बाद इसे अंतिम स्वरूप दिया जा सके ।

### **Minutes of the Meeting**

- 1) Miss Shraddha Shrivastav started the meeting by introducing herself and welcoming all the esteemed members and our revered Principal Ma'am Dr Preetha Nilesh
- 2) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee elaborated on all the internal curriculum that was conducted during the last academic year. A variety of fruitful activities such as Movie Reviews, Book Reviews, News Article Reviews, Case Study Presentations, Documentary Making, Data Presentation on Excel, Report Writing etc. were conducted across all the Six Semesters.
- 3) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee also informed the Board that the college is contemplating to buy a Software for conducting Mapping for Course Outcome in order to get a detailed insight into the learning outcomes of all the courses that are taught in the curriculum.
- 4) Following suggestions about the changes in the syllabus were made by the Department of Economics and other Members of the Board
  - a) Most of the Syllabus of the Second Year was kept as it is, since many changes had been made in the past meetings of the Board of Studies, the Department and the Board Members came to an agreement that the syllabus is quite updated and does not need any significant changes to be made.
  - b) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee mentioned that during the last Academic Year instead of Market Research the Department decided to take Elementary Quantitative Techniques as the applied component to introduce the students to the concepts of Mathematical Economics and Statistics. It was received very well by the students.
  - c) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee also mentioned that the Department conducted a poll with the students regarding the inclusion of two Quantitative Papers instead of the regular theory papers in the TY Syllabus or if they would like to learn the Quantitative Topics via a Certification Course. Following the poll, a discussion was also held through online mode with the students of TY. In the discussion the students were of the opinion that since some topics of Mathematics and Statistics were already taught to them in the second year and the inclusion of it has also been done in their regular syllabus of TY, they wished to have the two theory papers instead and learn more Quantitative Topics via the Certification Course.
  - d) Dr Vibhuti Patel suggested that the concept of "Atmanirbhar Bharat" should be included in the Paper of Indian Economy in the syllabus of SY but Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee mentioned that the concept is being taught in the TY Syllabus under the Paper of Economics of Development.

- e) As per the guidelines of Mumbai University, two Papers from Semester Six which are Development Theory and Experience and International Trade Policy and Practice were removed from the syllabus and were replaced by Environmental Economics II and History of Economic Thought II. The syllabus for both the papers is based on the same papers of T.Y.B.A. Economics Mumbai University Syllabus.
- f) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee suggested retaining the Financial Economics Paper owing to some of the lucrative Job Opportunities that it would provide the students with in the future. This suggestion was approved by all the members of the Board.
- g) Dr Vibhuti Patel suggested that the concept of Experimental Economics should be included in the TY Syllabus. The Department accepted the suggestion and mentioned that the practical application of the concept shall be included in the internal component of the Research Methodology Paper.
- h) Dr Vibhuti Patel also suggested inclusion of various methods of Triangulation in the syllabus of Research Methodology. This suggestion has also been accepted by the Department and shall be taught in the coming academic year.
- i) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee suggested that the second unit of the History of Economic Thought I (Semester 5) should be completely scrapped and replaced with a unit containing the winning thesis of the Nobel Laureates who won their respective Nobel Prizes before 1990. The thesis of the rest of the Nobel Laureates shall be taught in the last unit of the History of Economic Thought II (Semester 6) This suggestion was approved by the Board Members.
- j) The Department re-structured the syllabus of TY Macro Economics by taking references from the syllabus of Mumbai University and St Xavier's College, Mumbai. All the changes were approved by the Board.
- k) Miss Trishna Saraf suggested that a case study analysis can be done by the students regarding the recent failure of the American Banking System. The Department and the Board has accepted this suggestion and Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee stated that the case study analysis shall be conducted under the paper of Macro Economics as the last unit of this paper contains the topics related to the various Financial Crisis of the world.
- l) Miss Trishna Saraf suggested that India's Foreign Trade Policy 2023 that was announced recently should be included in the syllabus of International Economics. This suggestion was accepted by the Board and the Department.
- m) Miss Trishna Saraf and Dr Vibhuti Patel suggested that certain elements of economic applications should be introduced in the paper of Environmental Economics such as Research Papers on the economic applications of the concepts can be used as references. The students can themselves conduct a cost benefit analysis on some of the current issues such as Aarey Colony, Mumbai Metro, Pune Metro etc. This suggestion was also accepted by the Board and the Department.
- n) Under New Education Policy, the Department is still contemplating on how the curriculum can be modified and made relevant as the guidelines for the policy have been vaguely mentioned.

- o) Mrs. Vaishali Dhammapathee proposed to the Board that the college would like to commence an MA Course in Economics in the due course of time. The proposal was accepted by the Board.

Minutes of the Meeting:

1. Dr. Satwant Balse, Head, Department of History presided over the History BOS meeting which began at 2.30 PM. She welcomed the members and briefly stated the Purpose of the meeting.
2. Prof.(Dr.) Preeta Nilesh addressed all the BOS members.

3. Ms. Harshana Nikam presented the PowerPoint presentation and explained the academic and co-curricular activities of the department, proposed changes in the syllabus of some papers, examination pattern and introduction of MA course in History and certificate courses.
4. The proposed changes in some papers were
  - Paper 3: new paper for SYBA Semester 3, titled "India under the East India Company (1757-1858)" and "History of Modern India (1858-1947)" in Semester 4.
  - Paper 4: "History of Medieval India (1000 CE to 1526 CE)" in Semester 5 and "History of Medieval India (1526 CE to 1707 CE)" in Semester 6.
  - Paper 5: To increase the scope of study of the History of Contemporary India, it is proposed that we'll divide it across the two semesters. "History of Independent India (1947-1977)" in Semester 5 and "History of Independent India (1977-2000)" in Semester 6.
5. Suggestions were invited from the BOS members for FYBA papers according to the NEP Guidelines.
6. The proposal for M. A. in History and other short term courses beneficial for the students was presented. The BOS members approved it.
7. Dr. Meherjyoti and Dr. Ramila reviewed Paper 3 A and B and certain Suggestions were made.
  - To Change in the title of Paper 3 A unit 2.
  - Change in the Paper 3 B
    - To include Indian National Congress (1885 to 1920) to Unit 2 (C)
  - To Make changes in the Modules of Paper 3 B unit 3 as it was too vast for 11 lectures. Dr. Meherjyoti suggested that Revolutionary Nationalism can be added to this Unit along with Quit India Movement in unit (C)
  - Dr. Ramila and Dr. Meherjyoti opined that Unit 4 of Paper 3 B is again too vast and suggested trimming it to maintain the interest of the Students in history. They also told the Department to revisit Unit 2, 3 and 4 of Paper 3 B.
  - Dr. Meherjyoti suggested removing Ramkrishna Mission from Unit 4 Module (A) as Students study this at school level.
8. Dr. Meherjyoti also reviewed the syllabus of Paper (B) Medieval India (1526 -1707) and Paper 5 (A) History of Independent India (1947-1977) suggested certain changes in the order of the Modules.
9. The approval of BOS members was requested on the new question paper pattern (External Examination). It was suggested to introduce an option of short notes in question number 4 alongwith an option for essay type question. The BOS approved the proposed change.
10. Details of the seven listed short term Certificate courses were discussed. The BOS members opined that certain courses are too vast for 2 credits. They advised that titles of the course should be simple. They suggested removing the word 'Libraries' from the 'Certificate Course on Conservation and Preservation techniques in Museum, Archives and Libraries.'
11. Dr. Meherjyoti also requested us to check the credits for certificate courses under NEP and form courses. She advised us to refer to the CHETNA courses.
12. Prof. (Dr.) Preeta Nilesh proposed the plan to introduce an "open book" system for the external examination for the Research Methodology paper at TYBA. In response, Dr. Meherjyoti sought clarification on the duration and marks allotted for open book test, if a list of books would be given to the students, if students could refer to online sources and she suggested that questions should be based on analytical and philosophical topics.

13. This meeting marked the end of the three year tenure of the BOS. The meeting closed on a note of gratitude for the BOS members for their valueable time,support and suggestions regarding our autonomous syllabus.
14. The meeting concluded with a Vote of Thanks by Ms. Jaiee Bhat .
15. Action taken: we had a department meeting To review the suggestions of the BOS . We revisited the syllabus and brought certain changes.
  - We will keep the title of the Paper 3 (A) unit 2 as it is.
  - We restructured modules of Paper 3(B)
    - Unit 1 : No change
    - Unit 2 : Growth of Political and National Consciousness
      - A) Education and Press
      - B) Indian National Congress (1885-1920)
      - C) Revolutionary nationalism
    - Unit 3 : Indian National Movement (1918-1942)
      - A) M.K.Gandhi – early experiments with Satyagraha
      - B) Non-Cooperation Movement and Civil Disobedience Movement
      - C) Government of India Act (1935), Quit India Movement 1942
    - Unit 4 : Towards Independence and partition
      - A) Subhash Chandra Bose and Indian National Army
      - B) Cripps Mission (1942), India Independence Act (1947)
      - C) Partition and its impact
16. Dr. Meherjyoti suggested removing Ramkrishna Mission from Unit 4 Module (A) as Students study this at school level. We decided to keep it as part of Unit 2.
17. Department reviewed the syllabus of Paper 4 (B) Medieval India (1526 -1707) and Paper 5 (A) History of Independent India (1947-1977) and made changes in syllabus as per the suggestion of BOS members.
18. The department reviewed Paper 5 for semesters 5 and 6. The paper 5 for semester 5 will be “History of Independent India (1947-1977)” and “History of Contemporary India (1977-2000)” for semester 6.
19. The department decided to revisit all the titles of Certificate courses in order to make it more simple and interesting.
20. The department also decided to wait for NEP Guidelines to decide the credits that should be allotted to Certificate courses.
21. In response to Dr. Meherjyoti’s queries about the proposed “open book” system, following structure was prepared :
  - Time: 2 hrs
  - Max Marks: 60
  - Application based questions as far as possible.
  - Only hard copies of the books. Students have to carry their own hard copy of the books.
 We have given a list of books as a reading list in the syllabus.




1. The minutes of the previous BOS Meetings were shared with the BOS members.





### **Minutes of the Meeting**

#### **Agenda Point 1: To share the evaluation formats and extra and co-curricular activities done in AY 2022-23.**

Dr Neeta Mehta reviewed academic year 2022-23 by presenting evaluation pattern used and activities carried out throughout the year. She highlighted 40-60 marks (internal and external) assessment pattern and kind of project work students undertook for practicals internal assessment and the nature of semester end assessment conducted in both semesters. She also shared with the BOS members various activities and short-term courses that the department has carried out in AY 2022-23.

#### **Agenda Point 2a: To restructure the courses in alignment with the NEP: To get FY courses as Discipline-Specific Courses (DSCs) approved for AY 2023-24 onwards.**

Dr Neeta Mehta presented FYBA syllabi in the form of two Discipline Specific Core Papers that were revised keeping in mind the requirements of NEP.

Paper I: Fundamentals of Psychology: Basic Concepts and Processes

Paper II: Fundamentals of Psychology: Theories and Perspectives

Dr. Radhika Mohan appreciated the demarcation of the topics done in two separate papers and at the same time, expressed concern regarding too many subtopics in the syllabi, especially because students come from various background in FYBA. Dr Neeta Mehta responded to her concern by saying that some subtopics will be covered in the form of assignments that students will present in the class and also shared that the department conducts Bridge Course to bring non-psychology students (those who did not have psychology in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard) to the same level as psychology students (those who studied psychology in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard)

Ms Minal Koparde expressed that the syllabi of two papers of FYBA look holistic and has the depth in them.

The BOS approved the syllabi for two Discipline-Specific Core papers of FYBA.

**Agenda Point 2b: To restructure the courses in alignment with the NEP: To get SY and TY courses revised and approved for AY 2023-24 onwards (two and one year respectively) till NEP gets implemented for these levels of degree programmes.**

Dr Neeta Mehta presented SYBA Social Psychology course for AY 2023-24. Unit 4 of Semester 3 was omitted and Unit 1 of Semester 4 was added in semester 3 to make a complete paper titled “Social Psychology: Understanding and Responding to Social World”. She talked about the topic on “Group Influence” that was added in another separate paper in Semester 4 titled “Social Psychology: Processes Influencing Social Behaviour”.

Dr. Radhika Mohan supported the changes made. She said that Unit 4 of Semester 3 (Liking, Love and Intimate Relationship) is repeated in Developmental Psychology and omitting it in this paper is a right thing to do. She also approved the titles of the two papers which are revised to make two separate independent courses.

Ms. Reeta Kamble presented SYBA Developmental Psychology course that was revised for AY 2023-24. The revised syllabi focused on entire lifespan from conception to old age. From each unit psychosocial development is kept for students’ assignments and presentations.

Dr. Radhika Mohan agreed that the whole lifespan should be studied. However, she opined that keeping psychosocial development in all age groups for assignments is not a good idea, as it is an important aspect of development. Dr. Neeta Mehta assured her that students will not just do the assignments and submit them but will also make presentations in the class. That time if there are anything that they do not cover well, teacher will take a charge and explain it to the class. It was also resolved that instead of just psychosocial development, teacher will use her discretion to decide which subtopics of physical, cognitive or psychosocial development will be given as assignment topics in different age groups.

Ms Latika Suryavanshi suggested Adult Attachment Interview while teaching attachment styles, Positive Childhood Experiences and Adverse Childhood Experiences also to be made part of the syllabi.

Dr Neeta Mehta also talked about Health Psychology – Applied Component Paper that was not revised at all, as it is found to be satisfactory. Only revision which was introduced was the titles of two separate courses in two semesters – Fundamentals of Health Psychology and Health

Psychology: Management of Chronic and Terminal Illnesses

Ms Latika Suryavanshi suggested correlating students’ ACE (Adverse Childhood Experiences) score with their own health outcomes as they study health psychology.

Dr Neeta Mehta presented Paper IV, V, VIII and IX of TYBA and Reeta Kamble presented Paper VI, VII of TYBA and PHBW of TYBCom

Dr. Radhika Mohan appreciated the separation of Statistics in Psychology from Psychological Testing Paper in case of Paper IV of TYBA.

Prof Mrunal Bhardwaj suggested the title of Psychopathology I and Psychopathology II instead of Abnormal Psychology I and Abnormal Psychology II for paper V of TYBA.

She added that critique of DSM should be incorporated in the syllabi of one of courses.

Dr. Radhika Mohan asked about topic on sexual disorders which are not part of the syllabus. Dr Neeta Mehta explained that it has never been the part of syllabus since autonomy was introduced. However, Dr Mehta explained that these disorders including sexual orientation and Gender Identities will be covered in the form of workshop for psychology students and as an elective course for non-psychology students. She further added that whatever is not there in the syllabus including addictions, those topics are covered by giving students assignments on those topics which they present in the class.

Ms Latika Suryavanshi suggested use of Positive Childhood Experience and Adverse Childhood Experiences while teaching PD.

Ms Minal Koparde suggested that in the Performance Management and Development – one can add 360 degree feedback and development feedbacks can also be brought in in Paper VI syllabi of TYBA.

Prof Mrunal Bhardwaj suggested that in TYBA PAPER VII – Cognitive Psychology, artificial intelligence can be included.

With respect to Paper IX – Counseling Psychology - Dr. Radhika Mohan appreciated the overall organization of the counselling topics in two courses and reintroducing of the book by Welfel and Patterson (2006)

**Agenda Point 2c: To invite suggestions for Discipline-Specific Courses (DSCs), Discipline Specific Electives, Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs) (if applicable) and General Electives (GEs) (if applicable) that the department can offer once NEP is implemented for all the levels of degree programme.**

Dr Neeta Mehta talked about possible/ tentative Discipline Specific Core Courses, Discipline Specific Electives, General Electives and Skill Enhancement Courses that the Department of Psychology can offer under NEP.

Dr Neeta Mehta thanked the members of BOS for their contributions over a period of three years and closed the meeting.







7. The meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks.




