Academic Year 2026-2027**

- **Eligibility for In-House Status:** Only regular students of V.G. Vaze College who passed the HSC Examination in March 2026 are eligible for admission under the In-House quota.
- Students who completed SYJC Arts at Vaze College in 2025-2026 and passed the H.S.C. Examination are eligible for in-house admission only in their corresponding degree streams: B.A., B.Sc., or B.Com.
- Students who passed via Form No. 17 or prior to March 2026 are treated as OUTSIDERS.

Please Note:

- Students must strictly adhere to the schedule provided in this notice. No extensions will be granted for Vaze College in-house admission dates.
- The entire admission process will be conducted online. Offline forms will not be accepted for any course under any circumstances.
- Only online applications for Aided courses (FYBA / FYBSc / FYBCom) will be considered under the In-house quota.
- Students interested in Self-Financing Courses must apply separately. SFC admissions are categorised as "Outside Category"; therefore, In-house Aided admission forms are not valid for SFC applications.

IMPORTANT: SUBJECT ALLOTMENT (NEP GUIDELINES):

- **Note 1:** A student will select one subject as Major and one subject as Minor in Semester I out of the **36 combinations** (Please refer to the table given below).
- **Note 2: Hindi Literature** will remain **Minor** throughout the degree course.
- **Note 3:** All admissions are **provisional** subject to fulfillment of the requirements stated by the University of Mumbai.
- **Note 4:** All admissions will be as per the **Reservation Policy** circular of Government of Maharashtra adopted by the University of Mumbai.
- **Note 5:** Learners can interchange Major to Minor (Except for Psychology), at Semester III provided the vacancy of the seats in the preferred subjects. Such cases will be approved by the admission committee (authorities) at the end of semester II.
- **Note 6:** Learners will study the **VSEC Course** related to their **Major Course**.
- **Subject Exclusivity:** The following subjects will remain exclusive which means they cannot be opted together.

Admission Policy for FYBA (Psychology Major and Minor)

1. Intake Capacity for Psychology Major

Admission to the FYBA class with Psychology as a Major will be offered to a total of 65 students, selected strictly on the basis of merit and in accordance with the applicable reservation policy.

2. Allocation for Outside Students

Out of these 65 seats, 20 seats will be reserved for outside students, i.e., those who have completed their 12th

standard from institutions other than Vaze College and demonstrate academic merit. This allocation will include 5 seats under the management quota.

3. Reallocation of Unfilled Outside Quota Seats

In the event that the reserved 20 seats for outside students are not fully utilized, the remaining seats will be offered to eligible in-house students from the waiting list.

4. Intake Capacity for Psychology Minor

Admission to the FYBA class with Psychology as a Minor will be offered to 30 students. Of these, 5 seats may be reserved for outside students, i.e., those from institutions other than Vaze College.

5. Clarity Regarding Psychology Minor

Students admitted to the Psychology Minor will be informed at the time of admission that they will not be eligible to switch to Psychology as a Major in the second or third year of the B.A. program. In the case of seat availability at SY level we may allow minor students to shift to Major on case to case basis.

6. Eligibility Criteria

Students applying for the FYBA program with Psychology as a Major will be considered eligible irrespective of whether they have studied Psychology at the 10+2 level, across any stream.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE DURING THE ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ABC ID: It is mandatory to generate an ABC ID before starting the process via www.abc.gov.in.

1. **University Pre-Enrolment:** You must complete the Pre-Admission Online Enrolment on the University website: muugadmission.samarth.edu.in.
2. **Note:** This registration is mandatory for all University of Mumbai colleges but does not count as an application to Vaze College. You must fill out the college form separately.
3. **College Admission Form:** After completing the University registration, fill out the Vaze College Admission Form here: cimsstudentnewui.mastersofterp.in.
4. The following students will be treated as NON-VAZE COLLEGE (OUTSIDER) students and must apply through the outsider link:
 - Students who passed the HSC Examination in March 2026 via Form No. 17.
 - Students who passed the HSC Examination prior to March 2026.
5. All documents must be uploaded in PDF format, except for the photograph and signature, which must be image files (JPEG/PNG).

ADDITIONAL RULES & DISCIPLINE

- **Attendance:** As per University Ordinance 0.6086, **75% attendance** is **MANDATORY** for lectures and practicals.
- **Discipline:** Students are expected to maintain strict discipline on campus. Those with serious complaints of indiscipline against them will not be considered for admission in the 2026-2027 academic year.

IMPORTANT: UNIVERSITY REGISTRATION VS. COLLEGE ADMISSION

- **Mandatory University Enrollment:** The University of Mumbai “**PRE-ADMISSION ONLINE ENROLMENT FORM**” is a **MANDATORY**

requirement for all students seeking admission to any college affiliated with the University of Mumbai.

- Please note that University Registration does **NOT** constitute an application for admission to V.G. Vaze College (Autonomous).
- **Final Step:** To be considered for admission to V.G. Vaze College, you must fill out the College Online Application Form on our website in addition to the University Pre-Registration form.
- **One Form per Course:** Students must submit a separate application form for every program they are interested in. For instance, applying for B.Sc. does not mean you are automatically considered for B.A.; a second form is required.
- **Self-Financing Courses (SFC):** In-house students applying for SFC must use the Outsider application link; in-house forms are only valid for Aided courses.
- **No Extensions:** No admission requests will be entertained after the 21st May deadline.
